REQUIREMENTS:

- Need to be 18 years or older.
- Need a physical and a TB test within the past year.
- Take a pre-test on Tuesday, Dec. 2, 2008.
(will accommodate another date if necessary).
- Students will be responsible for uniforms and transportation to clinical site.



The 49 hour caregiver training course and related books will be free to the student. Classes begin Tuesday, January 27, 2009 at Capital Community College in Hartford, CT. Personal care attendant students will meet weekly through April 30, 2009.
