HOST FAMILIES NEEDED FOR INTERNATIONAL STUDENT EXCHANGE PROGRAM

Hartford, CT - Capital Community College is currently seeking host families for the **2008-09 Congress-Bundestag Youth Exchange Program for Young Professionals**. The program is an on-going, reciprocal exchange for career-minded young adults, and is supported by both the American and German governments.

Participants of the program have the opportunity to study at Capital Community College in the fall semester and intern at a local company during the spring semester. All participants are fully covered by a comprehensive medical insurance, are furnished a J-1 work visa by the U.S. State Department, Bureau of Educational and Cultural Affairs, and are required to purchase their own automobile. Upon request, a modest monthly stipend is available to host families to defray living expenses.

In the **Greater Hartford** area we are currently seeking a family, couple or single person interested in bringing a young German adult into their home for 6 to 11 months.
